NOTE TO ALL MAJORS:

- You must achieve a grade of **C (2.0) or better** in all required courses for the major, including Math.
- A minimum of 60 credits must be in non-Psychology courses.
- You must complete at least 39 credits of coursework at or above the 300 level (this includes both Psychology and non-Psychology courses).
- PSYX 290, 292, and 298 are limited to 6 credit hours.
- PSYX 298 and 398 (Service Learning courses) are not required; but an internship in an applied area is recommended.
- PSYX 392 and 398 are limited to 3 credit hours.

- ³PSYX 340, 360, & 385 may only count once.
- ⁴PSYX 360, Social Psychology = SOC 382, Social Psychology
