March 16<sup>th</sup>, 1906

A Chinese doctor known by the name of Charlie Can, and a pioneer resident of Butte, was found murdered in his home recently. He was supposed to be wealthy and robbery is alleged as the motive for the crime. A Chinaman has been arrested, but as yet there is little evidence to connect him with the crime.

July 13<sup>th</sup>, 1906

Deputy Collector of Customs David Hoover, stationed at Gateway, an entry port from Canada, on the Montana boundary line, has been arrested on complaint of R.H. Taylor, a secret service man sent out from Washington to investigate charges of a conspiracy to smuggle Chinese unlawfully into this country.
